## Gift Aid - Easily Understood

### What is Gift Aid?

It is a government scheme that enables the Association to reclaim the tax you have already paid on the money you give in your subscriptions.

### How does the Association benefit from Gift Aid?

While the basic rate of income tax is 22%, the Association can recover tax at the rate of approximately 28p on every £1 given.

### Who can give through Gift Aid?

Anyone who pays Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax.

### What is Required?

1. Giving your subscriptions through Standing Order or by cheque – this provides the Association with the necessary record of your giving.
2. Sign a Gift Aid Declaration

### You do not need.....

- To promise to give a particular amount each year
- To promise to give for a specified period of time

### Gift Aid is Good Stewardship

Giving your subscription/donation as a Gift Aid contribution makes your contribution worth more.

More money means more can be done to further the aims of the Association.
